Meeting Minutes

1800 – President Brad Winters opened the meeting.

Five members were present: Kellie Carlsen, Brad Winters, Ed Henry, Mike Wickman and Richard Willbur.

Richard Willbur presented the treasurer's report: \$13, 183,80 in the General Fund and approximately \$80,000.00 in the Norm May account.

We currently have 168 members.

Ed made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Mike seconded the motion. All approved.

Kellie Carlsen read the May minutes. Ed made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Mike seconded the motion. All approved.

Old Business:

1. The June 18th shoot is cancelled.
2. The motorcycle event will not be coming across the WMGC property.
3. The fence has 4 wires cut at the top of the property needing repair. Brad has repaired the fence at the bottom of the property.
4. Mike noted garbage at the 200-yard target.
5. Hats have been ordered.
6. Brad built the road. There was a need for 3 more loads of gravel than initially estimated.

Richard made a motion to reimburse Brad for the cost of his fuel, which was 20 gallons of diesel for his pickup and the backhoe. Ed seconded the motion. All approved, except Brad, who abstained.

7. Entry and Exit signs are needed. Ed made a motion to approve purchase of signs. Mike seconded the motion. All approved. Richard will order the signs.
8. The weed spraying is done. WMGC will receive an invoice from the contractor.

9. Weed eating needs to be done.
10. Richard is updating the website. Richard has updated Facebook, Twitter, and the Webpage reflecting the dates for the upcoming motorcycle race.

New Business:

1. Richard met with the tax preparer. An extension has been filed.
2. The gravel is considered range improvement. Payment will come from the Norm May fund.
3. Per Ed, the "Range Closed" signs are ready.
4. Richard is working on group notices through E Mail and Text Messages.
5. It was decided that a newsletter two times per year to all members providing updates on club happenings will encourage more participation and interest in club events. Kellie will draft those letters. Kellie and Richard will work on ways to effectively get them out to the membership. Kellie will have a draft letter for the next meeting.
